SPRING BREAK IN JAPAN

Visit Japan with the **Management** department's new 2010 spring break study abroad program. Students will take a **ten day study abroad trip to Japan** over spring break 2010 – while earning class credit for Special Topics – Business in Japan class (Spring 10 - 3 credit hours).



The program will run during the spring semester and will include a 10-day visit to Japan from **March 19th** through **March 28rd**. Participants will be visiting four cities in Japan - **Tokyo, Nagoya, Kyoto and Osaka.**

The ten day stay in these four cities will include visits to **international business firms**, talks by **Japanese University Professors** and **sightseeing tours to world famous sites.**

Some of the sites visited include.....

- *Heian Shrine and Gold Pavilion*
- *Meiji Shinto Shrine*
- *Imperial Palace*
- *Cruise on the Sumida River to Tokyo's Amusement Center*
- *Asakusa Kannon Temple*

The trip will cost approximately **\$3,856**, which will include.....

- **Roundtrip airfare to Japan**
- **All airfare between cities.**
- **8 overnight stays in hotels with private bathrooms and eight dinners.**
- **Visits to 4 businesses and 1 lecture.**
- **Select Guides and entrances to special attractions per itinerary.**
- **Full-time bilingual EF Tour Director.**

There is a possibility of **some program related financial aid** being available.



This program is open to all business majors and minors.
