- Please sign-up for an interview when you drop off your application.

Expectation of Applicants:

- Two completed recommendation forms are mandatory. One to be completed by your current Chapter President and the other is to be completed by your Advisor or a faculty/staff member. These forms can be faxed to: **678-839-6481**
- All applicants must be prompt and prepared for their interview time. Missing the scheduled interview time will result in disqualification from the selection process.

Panhellenic Executive Council Eligibility Requirements:

- Officers shall serve a term of one year
- Officers must be a full time student (12 hours or more) with at least a 2.5 cumulative grade point average and must be an active member and in good standing of her chapter
- Officers are required to do a set amount of office hours as approved by the Greek Advisor
- Officers are required to attend all Panhellenic meetings and Exec meetings scheduled for Tuesday at 4 pm for spring 2010 and fall 2010 semesters (This is non-negotiable)
- Officers must be available during the summer for orientation and pre-recruitment events and for University Preview Days
- Officers must be able to attend a mandatory training weekend on February 19 – 20, 2010
