Electives

(29 hours). Can be from any department, at least 8 hours need to be at or above 3000 level. You can declare a minor, but it is not required. A minor would involve 11-14 elective hours instead of 29.

Important Things to Keep in Mind about Advising:

- a) you need 120 hours to graduate, 39 of which need to be above the 3000 level
- b) you need to declare Psychology as your major by filling out the requisite paperwork with the department secretary
- c) to declare psychology as your major, you need 45 completed hours, a C or better in PYSC 1101, AND one of the following: either a 2.5 cumulative GPA or three B's in any PSYC courses
- d) you cannot use the same course to count in more than one category of this checklist
- e) meet regularly with your advisor, and talk about your career rather than just the courses you need for next semester
- f) if you are interested in Graduate School or internships, talk to your advisor early rather than waiting until your senior year.
