I understand the minimum admissions requirements for the Gifted Junior Program are:

1. SAT critical reading score of 580 or ACT English score of 25.
2. SAT math score of 530 or ACT math score of 22.
3. High school academic grade point average of 3.50 as computed in college prep courses.
4. On track to complete and graduate with a collage prep high school diploma.
5. Not required to be screened for any Learning Support, remedial course work.

The Gifted Junior Program is for high school juniors who live within commuting distance (30 miles) of the University. Gifted Junior students are not eligible to live in campus residence halls. I further understand that students in the Gifted Junior Program are limited in the courses and number of course hours that may be taken each semester.

Gifted Junior participants may continue taking pre-college courses as a high school senior without having to reapply for admission—provided the student is academically eligible. However, for any enrollment at UWG beyond high school graduation, I understand that a new admission application and final high school transcript showing date of high school graduation and completion of a college prep diploma **must** be submitted to the Office of Admissions.
