I acknowledge that participation in a study abroad program involves some risk of injury, illness, or loss of personal property, I agree to release and forever discharge the institution through which I am registering for the program, the University of West Georgia, and the Board of Regents of the University System of Georgia, its members individually, and its officers, agents, and employees, from any and all claims, demands, rights, and causes of action of whatever kind or nature, arising from and by reason of any and all known and unknown, foreseen and unforeseen bodily and personal injuries, including death, damages to property and the consequences thereof, resulting from my participation in the Summer 2008 Study Abroad Program in France for the UWG Art department and related activities.

I hereby agree to maintain accident and health insurance in force and effect for the entire duration of my participation in the study abroad program. I further certify that, to the best of my knowledge, I am in good health and physically capable of undertaking an intensive program of foreign study; any medical or health-related problems have been explicitly described in this application.

I hereby agree that I shall be subject to the supervision and authority of the faculty in charge and to standards of conduct stipulated by the faculty in charge. I further acknowledge that the supervising faculty or program director has sole authority to make decisions regarding the continued participation of any individual in the program whose conduct may necessitate disciplinary action. I further authorize the supervising faculty or program director to obtain and provide medical treatment and/or services that I may require during the study abroad program.

I am aware that the deadline for my submission of this application is February 1, 2008 by noon, and I agree to abide by the deadlines for fee payments as follows:

February 1st, noon - \$200 application fee (non-refundable)

February 1st, noon - first payment of \$1,500

March 31st, noon - final payment of \$2,200 + non-UWG fee or out-of-state fee

I further acknowledge that should I withdraw from the program, payments are nonrefundable following the above deadlines.

Note: All withdrawals must be made in writing to the Department of Art, University of West Georgia in order for refunds (if any) to be processed.

Funds from the net proceeds of the program may be used for scholarships in subsequent years.

All participants must be 18 years old by July, 3rd 2008 to be eligible to participate in the program.

In case of injuries, I hereby authorize and give consent to the program leaders to obtain and provide medical treatment as deemed necessary.

Application form must be accompanied by a \$200-check to cover for application fee.
This program is on a first come first serve basis, so please apply early as space is limited.

Submission of the application form constitutes a formal commitment to participate in the 2008 UWG Art Study Abroad Program in France Summer 2008 and acceptance of the policies outlined therein.

Cancellation of Program

University of West Georgia has the right to cancel the program due to low enrollment or unforeseen developments. If the program is cancelled before the program begins, participants will receive full refund of all amounts paid up to the time of cancellation. If the program is cancelled after it has started, there will be no refund unless the University is able to recover some funds from the providers. In that case, students will be reimbursed on a pro-rata basis.

At all times, participants are expected to abide by the University of West Georgia student handbook policies and to comply with the French laws as well as the rules of the institutions they will be staying at.
