Applications are invited for several \$2,000 scholarships for students to study Anthropology at the University of West Georgia. These competitive awards for Anthropology majors are based upon academic achievement and potential for scholarly growth.

Applications for the Waring Anthropology Scholarship are welcomed from

- graduating high school seniors who will attend UWG and major in Anthropology
- all Anthropology majors at UWG
- transfer students who will major in Anthropology at UWG

These awards are in addition to any other grants or aid the student may receive.

Applications for the Waring Anthropology Scholarships dispersed during the 2008-2009 academic year (Fall & Spring semesters) will be accepted anytime this academic year until 4:00pm February 4, 2008.

*** * * * Application Requirements * * * ***

1. Official copy of academic transcripts if currently enrolled or transferring to UWG [or] Official copy of high school transcripts and SAT or ACT scores if applying as a graduating high school senior
2. Cover letter.
3. Essay (typed, double-spaced between 250 and 500 words) on "Why I want to study Anthropology".

For disbursement of a Waring Scholarship award, the recipient must

1. be a declared Major in Anthropology at the University of West Georgia
2. enroll in and successfully complete at least 12 semester hours of coursework during each semester of the award
3. enroll in and successfully complete one or more Anthropology courses during each semester of the award

For a scholarship recipient to be eligible to apply for a Waring Scholarship award for a subsequent academic year, the recipient must

1. be a full-time student, provide evidence of satisfactory progress towards fulfilling the requirements for a Major in Anthropology, and remain in good academic standing throughout the period of their scholarship award.
2. have a minimum 3.25 GPA for all Anthropology courses and an overall GPA of at least 3.0, or provide an acceptable explanation of why either is lower.
3. submit a 250-500 word double-spaced typed essay discussing how their Anthropology courses have affected how they view the world.
