\*Prerequisite: Admission to the Teachers Education program. Admission requires a GPA of 2.7 and passing the GACE Skills Assessment Test.

\*Admission to the Teaching Internship requires the satisfactory completion of prerequisite education courses. Application must be made by May of the calendar year prior to the internship term. A \$250.00 fee will be assessed by the College of Education.

\* During the final semester of the junior year, all candidates must enroll in Art 4078 and present a comprehensive portfolio of artwork to date. Portfolios will be evaluated by the Department of Art Faculty. Candidates must pass course to fulfill the prerequisite for Art 4998 Sr Capstone Experience I. work, and present a BFA thesis, exhibition, and oral defense of art/design work. This exhibition must be held in a space approved by the Department of Art.

\* Courses of variable credit must be taken for three credit hours per semester unless otherwise approved by both the Instructor and the Department Chair.

\* Independent studies or directed readings may be taken toward the fulfillment of Art Electives with the approval of both the Instructor and Department Chair.

\* No course may be substituted for listed required courses without approval of the Department Chair.

\* There is no Physical Education requirement nor will any Physical Education class count as an elective.
