

## **Terry Lowry**

Composer, pianist and conductor **Terry Lowry** was born in Albany, Georgia. He studied piano and composition with his father, Terry Lowry, Sr., with whom he toured extensively performing duo piano recitals. Mr. Lowry received his Bachelor's of Music degree in piano performance from Shorter College and his Master of Music degree in music composition from the University of Alabama. His teachers include William Knight and Amanda Penick (piano); Peter DeWitt, Craig First and Marvin Johnson (composition); Fred Goosen (counterpoint); John Ratledge and Eric Nelson (conducting).

Mr. Lowry maintains a busy performing schedule with over 100 appearances annually as both solo recitalist and accompanist across the United States and Europe. In 1994 he was added to the prestigious list of International Steinway Artists. Mr. Lowry's commissions include the Verona International Choral Festival, the Carroll Symphony Orchestra, the Etowah Chamber Orchestra, the vocal ensemble RareSong, the University of Alabama Tuba Quartet and numerous soloists. Mr. Lowry is also an active teacher, conductor, and church musician and currently serves as Music Director at First Baptist Church in Carrollton, Georgia, and as Conductor and Music Director of the Carroll Symphony Orchestra. He has also served as an adjunct professor of music at Shorter College and the University of West Georgia. Mr. Lowry and wife Julie have two daughters, Anna and Allison.
