**A Special Issue of *JAISA* (Journal of the Association for the Interdisciplinary Study of the Arts)**

In fall 2011, *JAISA* will publish a special issue containing articles related to the conference topics from 2010: "WORD/ IMAGE/ CULTURE."

We welcome submissions from scholars in all areas of the humanities, including Foreign Languages and Literatures, English, Comparative Literature, Philosophy, Psychology, Theater, Visual Arts, Music, and Cultural studies. Papers must be submitted in English to be considered for publication. Quotes can either be solely in translation or in the original, accompanied by a translation. We particularly encourage conference participants to expand and revise their papers for submission.

Beginning with the 2011 issue, the editors of *JAISA* are Eugenio Di Stefano and Lisa Connell, both of the University of West Georgia. *JAISA* is listed in the MLA bibliography.

**Submission Guidelines:**

Manuscripts should be no shorter than 4000 words and no longer than 7500 words in length (including footnotes – not endnotes – and works cited). They should be written in Times New Roman 12 pt. Citation should conform to the most recent edition of the MLA Style Manual format (7<sup>th</sup> edition).

Manuscripts will be blind reviewed by scholars in the relevant fields.
