

**University of West Georgia – Graduate School
 Request for GMAT Waiver**

In an effort to attract highly qualified applicants, in rare instances the GMAT requirement for admission to the MBA program may be waived for MBA applicants with substantial management experience. This waiver is granted by the RCOB graduate admissions committee after a thorough review of the applicant’s resume and transcripts. To be considered an applicant must have at least a 2.5 undergraduate GPA. Normally the waiver will not be considered unless the applicant has 5 or more years at the level of Director or higher.

In order for this request to be processed, the applicant should submit the completed waiver form, a current resume, and official transcripts to the graduate school. The applicant’s admission file cannot be processed for an admission decision until a GMAT score or an approved waiver has been received by the Graduate School.
