Enclosed are the international student application forms. Please complete and return them with the \$30.00 (U.S. Currency) non-refundable application fee at your earliest convenience. In addition, several other items are needed in order to determine your eligibility for admission. This includes two official transcripts showing your completion of a four-year degree, an official TOEFL score, and an official admissions test score.

Enclosed is a financial affidavit. It must be completed accurately and returned to the Graduate School Office. Prior to acceptance, you must demonstrate financial solvency. You must fully fund all expenses incurred by your stay in the country.


Applicants with demonstrated superior academic ability are invited to apply for a waiver of the non-resident portion of tuition. To be considered for a waiver you must meet the following minimum requirements:

	<u>Minimum Score</u>
TOEFL	550 (paper-based test) 213 (computer-based test)
TOEFL iBT	79-80 (internet-based test)
GMAT*	480
GRE* (each section)	450

* Applicants are also required to submit an analytical writing test score for the GRE and the GMAT.
