

PROOF OF IMMUNIZATION REQUIRED

All new applicants to the Graduate School at the University of West Georgia for Spring Semester 2005 and beyond must present proof of immunization against measles, mumps, and rubella [MMR] (2 doses)*, Tetanus [dT] (within 10 years), Hepatitis B (if born on/after January 1, 1989), and Varicella (Chickenpox)**. The requirement applies to all new applicants for graduate programs at the University of West Georgia who were admitted after summer quarter 1991. These requirements also apply to those who were admitted prior to summer quarter 1991, but never enrolled. All applicants subject to the policy should submit a satisfactory Certificate of Immunization before the classes begin for the term in which they are interested in enrolling. Please understand that you will not be allowed to register for classes until the immunization requirement is fulfilled. * The MMR vaccinations are not required for students born before 1957.

** The Varicella (Chickenpox) vaccination is required for students born in the United States on or after January 1, 1980; or for all students born outside of the United States regardless of year.

All applicants subject to the policy should submit a satisfactory Certificate of Immunization by the following dates:

For Spring Semester 2008 – November 27, 2007

For Summer Semester 2008 – May 12, 2008
