

FINANCIAL SUPPORT

Each year the Department offers a number of Graduate Assistantships. These are 9-month assistantships for students enrolled in our Masters Degree program. It includes a stipend and a tuition waiver. For 2008-09, the anticipated stipend is \$10,000 for the year. Typical duties include tutoring, covering recitation sections in 1000-level mathematics classes, and grading.

It is expected that most of the work responsibilities of the assistantship will be done during the daytime hours (between 8AM and 5PM).

Note: students must be enrolled in six credit hours during each semester in order to be eligible for the assistantship for that semester.

To apply for an assistantship for the coming academic year:

1. Fill out the "Graduate Assistantship Application" (see: <http://www.westga.edu/~gradsch/finaid/index.html>) and submit to the Graduate School.
2. Indicate your request to be considered for an assistantship to the Department Chair (landman@westga.edu) no later than June 1, 2008, and include your resume. Since Graduate Assistantships are competitive, we encourage you to submit your application as early as possible.
