

## REQUEST FOR GMAT WAIVER

In some instances the Graduate Management Aptitude Test (GMAT) requirement for admission to the Masters of Business Administration (MBA) program in the Richards College of Business may be waived if substantial management experience and/or strong academic credentials are presented. This waiver may be granted at the discretion of the Dean or Dean's designate after a thorough review of the applicant's resume and/or transcripts. At the discretion of the Dean or designate, only one opportunity exists to request a GMAT waiver. Decisions will be made based on the materials submitted and additional data will not be requested. To be considered for a waiver an applicant must clearly define and support the request by adequately describing his/her particular justification.

In order for this request to be processed, the applicant should submit the completed Request for GMAT Waiver form (see below), a current resume, and transcripts, if warranted. The applicant's admission cannot be completed until a decision concerning the GMAT waiver has been made.
