- (2) Students will be notified via UWG email if they have received an award.
- (3) In order to receive the award, a student must have at least a 2.5 GPA and be enrolled at UWG with the intention of participating in a RCOB study abroad program or student exchange program during the semester of the award.
- (4) International program scholarships are not awarded to students who are classified as non-resident aliens.
