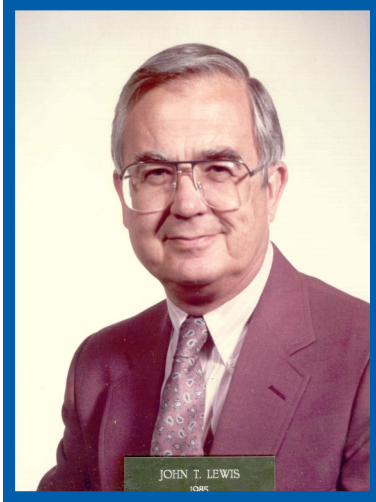

He was the former president of the Carrollton Rotary Club and the Director of the Carroll County Sertoma Club for 1995-1996.

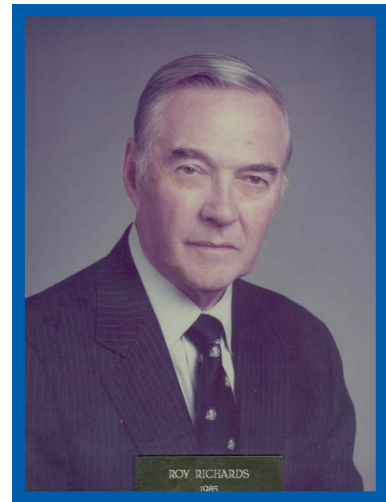
He retired from the College on April 2, 1993.
