Cliff Oxford

Mr. Oxford, a native of Waycross, worked his way through college loading trucks for the United Parcel Service (UPS). Upon graduating from UWG with a Bachelor of Arts degree in political science, he was hired by UPS full-time. His achievements at UPS include becoming the youngest district manager (at age 23) and championing the development of a new, technologically advanced help desk for the company.

Mr. Oxford went on to obtain a Master of Business Administration, started STI Knowledge, Inc., and was also recognized by the Gartner Group as a “Visionary and Execution” high-tech leader in 2003. In addition, Mr. Oxford was recognized as “Entrepreneur of the Year” by the Atlanta Chamber of Commerce in 2000.

Following his vision for entrepreneurship, Mr. Oxford endowed the Emory Executive MBA program in 2004, now known as the W. Cliff Oxford Emory Executive MBA program. His vision was to unite the Emory MBA program with an entrepreneurial curriculum and focus. Under his guidance, within two years the program was ranked number 6 in the world by *Business Week* magazine. In addition, the program is ranked number 4 among students and number 3 in the management skills category of the *Wall Street Journal's* survey on Executive MBA programs.
