**Requirements and Instructions**

1. Each image must include: applicant's last name, first name, image#. example: smith\_melinda\_08
2. Artist Statement – up to one page in length.
3. Application Letter - If you are applying for more than one scholarship (example: General Scholarship, Betty Andre, & Bessie Curran) you may submit one letter, which covers the various scholarships for which you are eligible. Example:

*"Dear Scholarship committee,*

*Please consider me for the General Scholarship Competition, the Joyce Entrekin Scholarship, & ..."*

4. Certain Scholarships require specific information in addition to the Application form. Many will pertain to specific majors etc.
5. Copies of current FAFSA form or statement of need
