



Water/Wastewater Internship Program

This program is designed to provide an approved candidate the opportunity to enter into an internship for the purpose of achieving certification per State of Georgia guidelines as either a Water Treatment or Wastewater Treatment System Operator Class III. The candidate has the option of choosing whichever internship is most desirable to them. All background/drug checks, books, GWWI tuition, and testing fees are included in the tuition price.

The internship consists of:

- A minimum of 228 hours on-the-job training in a certified water or wastewater treatment plant
- 40 hours of classwork at the Georgia Water Wastewater Institute (GWWI)
- Successful completion of a state certification examination
