University Requirements:

1. Complete an [application](#) for graduate admission;
2. Non-refundable \$40.00 application fee;
3. One official transcript from each college or university attended;
4. [Certificate of Immunization](#) must be sent directly to the Office of Student Health Services (Only applicable to new students);

Department Requirements:

5. 2.5 cumulative undergraduate GPA on a 4.0 scale
6. An official score of the Graduate Record Exam (GRE) - of 400 on each: Quantitative and Verbal under the old scoring system, which translates into 140 quant, and 146 on the verbal under the new scoring system
7. Three [letters of recommendation](#) – The Department of Psychology requires that college level faculty who are familiar with the applicant's academic abilities submit at least two of the three letters of recommendation. The third letter may be submitted by an employer and/or supervisor. Exceptions may be made in special cases with permission from the Chair of the Department of Psychology.
8. *Personal Statement
9. An interview with departmental faculty is required. Interview dates and times to be arranged by the Department of Psychology.

***MA – PSYCHOLOGY – Applicants are required to submit a semi-autobiography of “where you are in your life and how you got there”, your interests in psychology and related areas, and why the University of West Georgia’s program in Humanistic Psychology is of special interest to you.
