UTV 13 airs programming 24 hours on Charter Communications Channel 13, and serves as an experiential learning laboratory for Mass Communications majors. The station provides quality educational, informational and entertaining programming to the campus and local community, and affords opportunities for students, regardless of major, to participate in programming. Students write, produce, direct, shoot, and edit programs that enhance their understanding and appreciation of all aspects of television production. The UTV-13 program guide changes three times a year: January, June, and September. Beyond student-originated programming, UTV broadcasts PBS and GPB programs. Program offerings include sports, news, public affairs, comedic performances, quiz shows, cooking shows, and university lectures. UTV also honors requests to post community announcements, free of charge.
