

# Teacher Education Application Deadlines

Fall 2022 deadline: June 3, 2022

Spring 2022 deadline: Dec. 3, 2021

For Teacher Education Admission, you must:

- Submit passing **GACE Program Admission Assessment** or exemption scores.
- Submit completion of the **Georgia Educator Ethics Assessment**.
- Once assessments are completed, contact your COE Academic Advisor for Teacher Education and Pre-Service Application submission instructions.

## FAQs

### When should I take the assessments?

- You should plan to take the assessments after you have completed Area A of core.

### How do I avoid missing the application deadline and delaying graduation?

- **Plan Ahead**
  - \* Cost: The combined cost of the assessments is at least \$158.
  - \* Timing: Do not wait for the deadline to take the test - leave yourself time for a retest if necessary.
- **Prepare**
  - \* Use prep materials at [gace.ets.org](http://gace.ets.org) to familiarize yourself with the test. Tutoring for the Math and Writing portions is available in the Center for Academic Success.
- **Communicate**
  - \* Contact your COE Academic Advisor once you have passed and completed the assessments or if you have any questions.

**Program Admission Test I - Reading (210)**  
**Program Admission Test II - Mathematics (211)**  
**Program Admission Test III - Writing (212)**  
**Program Admission Combined Test I, II, and III (710)**

For admission to Teacher Education, you must pass all 3 parts (Reading, Math and Writing) with a score of 250 on each part, or have a composite score of at least 750 by combining all 3 parts.

### Registration Deadline

Registration for all tests must be completed at least two full days before the test date (not including the day of registration and the day of the test).

### Testing Fees

### Score Report Dates

Please list UWG as a score recipient. Scores are generally available four weeks from the beginning of the testing window in which you tested. You will be notified by email when your score report becomes available.

## Georgia Educator Ethics Assessment

The Georgia Educator Ethics Assessment must be completed for admission to Teacher Education. The score reporting deadline is the same as the GACE Program Admission score deadline for each semester.

### Score Reporting

In order to be admitted to Teacher Education, you must add your program provider (UWG) as a score recipient when you register for the assessment.

### Eligibility

You must create or update your MyPSC account on the GaPSC website and select your reason for testing (see below) to request eligibility.

### Educator Ethics - (360)

Select 7 as your reason for testing. You will then be eligible to take Georgia Educator Ethics
