### **Application checklist**

In order to be considered for University of West Georgia's Noyce Scholarship, you must submit the following items to the Fusion Center Lobby in the Ed Annex by March 6<sup>th</sup> at 5:00pm.

- \_\_\_\_\_ I. A typed and completed UTeach Scholarship/Internship Application
- \_\_\_\_\_ II. A letter of intent, describing why the applicant is applying for the Noyce Scholarship and what makes the applicant stand out from other candidates
- \_\_\_\_\_ III. An essay on STEM education, part one of the essay should discuss the importance of providing 6th -12th grade students with a quality STEM education and part two should include an example of how a STEM topic could be taught in a manner that positively affects student learning. The example should demonstrate the applicant's ability to effectively translate content and pedagogy into practice.
- \_\_\_\_\_ IV. An up to date résumé
- \_\_\_\_\_ V. An unofficial student transcript from Banweb
- \_\_\_\_\_ VI. Two letters of reference in sealed envelopes bearing the authors signature on the back of the envelope: one from UWG STEM Faculty and another from an UWG UTeach Faculty member.

In order for your application to be considered, you need to have the above items completed and placed in a manila envelope, with this form completed attached to the front. Incomplete applications will not be considered for funding. By signing and dating below, you agree that all information included in this packet is accurate and in regards to the essay your own work. Providing false information will also disqualify you from the selection process.
