- ✓ MEDT 7452 should be taken before or concurrently with MEDT 7461
- ✓ MEDT 7461 should be taken before MEDT 7465
- ✓ MEDT 7455 should be taken before or concurrently with MEDT 7454
- ✓ MEDT 7487 **must** be taken last in the SLM Focused Core course sequence

IT Certification Coursework:

- MEDT 7461 or MEDT 7464 should be taken **before** MEDT 7476.
- The IT Certification courses are offered every semester except for MEDT 7476, which is not offered during summer semester.
- You will be authorized to take the GACE Instructional Technology Assessment during the semester in which you complete your final IT Certification course.
