



University of West Georgia Speech-Language Pathology Personal Statement Guidelines

All applicants are required to submit a personal statement as a part of their application. The statement should follow the guidelines and address Topics 1 and 2, and Topics 3 and 4 are optional. If you address Topic 3 or 4 you may exceed the two-page length up to three pages.

Guidelines

- No cover page, name and title in header.
- 2 Page length
- Double-spaced
- Margins: 1 inch on each side
- Times New Roman font
- Font size: 12

Topic 1: Describe how your lived experience has shaped your goals and aspirations.

Topic 2: Explain how you will contribute to the academic and clinical culture of the speech-language pathology program at the University of West Georgia.

Topic 3: Address any particular challenges you have faced and how you have worked to overcome them.

Topic 4: If there is any additional information you would like to share or clarify about your application, please do so.
