

Collaborators and Other Affiliations Information

NSF will require the use of a [template](#) for identifying collaborators and other affiliations (COA). This information must be separately provided for each individual identified as senior project personnel. Please note that some information requested in prior versions of the PAPPG is no longer requested. **THIS IS PURPOSEFUL AND NSF NO LONGER REQUIRE THIS INFORMATION TO BE REPORTED.**

The template has been developed to be fillable, however, the content and format requirements must not be altered by the user, i.e., additional columns must not be added. This template can be saved in .xlsx or .xls format, and directly uploaded into FastLane/Research.gov as a Collaborators and Other Affiliations Single Copy Document. FastLane/Research.gov will convert the uploaded .xlsx or .xls files to .PDF. Using the .xlsx or .xls format will enable preservation of searchable text that otherwise would be lost. It is therefore imperative that this template be uploaded in .xlsx or .xls **only**. Uploading the template in any format other than .xlsx or .xls may delay the timely processing and review of your proposal.

DO NOT CHANGE OR ALTER THE FORMAT OF THE TABLE IN ANY WAY AS THIS WILL CREATE PRINTING AND VIEWING ERRORS

Proposers using the Collaborators and Other Affiliations template for more than 10 senior project personnel will encounter proposal print preview issues. If there are more than 10 individuals designated as senior project personnel on the proposal, or if there are print preview issues when using the COA template, each completed template must be saved as a .txt file [select the Text (Tab Delimited) option] rather than as an .xlsx or .xls file. This format will still enable preservation of searchable text and avoid delays in processing and review of the proposal.

Grants.gov Users: The COA information must be provided through use of the COA template and uploaded as a PDF attachment.
