UWG POLICY NAME: Accreditation Requirements

The University of West Georgia (UWG) is responsible for complying with the policies of its regional accreditor, the Southern Association of Schools and Colleges Commission on Colleges (SACSCOC), and the Board of Regents of the University System of Georgia. Notification and reporting of any substantive change by an accredited institution are mandated by the U.S. Department of Education regulation 34 CFR 602.22.


