

### I. Presidential Search Update, Special Election, A Day (Allyson)

## V. Committee Updates (Allyson)

#### VI. Other Business/Questions

**a.** Watson Hall is scheduled for demolition on August 28<sup>th</sup>. Prior to that, the parking by Watson will be closed off.



- **b.** Watson parking lot will remain closed for about a year and a half with the construction of the new business building. Strozier has been designated as Fac/Staff parking, but has fewer spaces than Watson parking lot. Strozier parking will go offline at the end of September to reconfigure and add more spots. Strozier parking will be back online sometime in November with 100 spots.
- **c.** Spaces have been added for Fac/Staff in Tyus Parking lot and the parking lot by the Education Building is open parking.
- **d.** The shopper shuttle has been shut down due to lack of funding. It costs \$20,000/year to run. Currently there are discussions of where to find more funding to reopen the shopper shuttle large concern to international students and those without cars.
- **e.** The Campus Center parking lot has been changed from Fac/Staff to open parking.
- **f.** Groundbreaking for the new business building should occur over Homecoming.
- **g.** Hanger Gym and Rec field are designated as Animal Relocation Center in case of a natural disaster. Federal government prohibits destroying or rebuilding this site without designating another location to serve the same purpose.
