SAC Updates, Discussion and Gossip

- Guest Speaker: Dr. Crafton, Interim UWG President – run down of SAC purpose, officers, around 40 reps
As Provost he was to work with Staff often. Potentially invite Dr. Jenks to speak? – Group to Provost

 - UCC built in the 1960's – needs to be removed – Row is not on the list to be removed – green space to be in the place of the UCC
 - Anthropology to be demolished
 - Master Plan – Facilities – Emily to follow up
 - Love Valley – heart of campus
 - Budget – good – no cuts – decent allocation for board, increase for tuition & grad tuition – E tuition absorbed
 - 2% is in – 1.4 million merit
 - PAC – summer hours – morale – proposals – orientation – HR ½ hour lunch – 4:30 on Friday – adjust to your non-busy time – adjustment – work/life balance
