- We encourage 15 hours per semester to graduate in 4 years.
- Estimated costs of attendance are costs that are paid to UWG, such as tuition, fees, meal plans, and on-campus housing.
- Tuition costs will vary based on the number of hours in which the student enrolls (\$174.20/hour for the 2016-2017 academic year). At least twelve hours is considered full-time enrollment.
- All freshmen living in a residence hall must select at least the Basic Membership meal plan (\$1,439). Refer to Campus Dining Services for more details at westga.edu/dinewest
- Books are not included on a student's invoice. However, since students usually purchase books for class, we included an estimated amount to assist when estimating the Cost of Attendance.
- All amounts provided are based on 2016-2017 costs and are subject to change for the 2017-2018 academic year. Financial Aid is typically awarded and available for review in May.
- All financial aid is awarded based on eligibility. Learn more at westga.edu/finaid.
