 - a. From the Provost:

I'm happy for the Faculty Senate to take up a handbook update on curricular and content review process/policy. It would benefit UWG to have more clearly defined curricular review processes. I mentioned my experience with ABET for regular curricular review as part of the required continuous improvement criteria. One approach that academic programs could take is conduct a peer review of 1/3 of courses every three years (so that all courses are reviewed at least once every three years). This is good design and allows faculty to regularly review materials, update for relevance/currency, and build peer-reviewed content from which faculty can select readings. This is likely most needed for lower-level and general education courses with many sections, improving coherence among sections; upper-level and graduate courses often have fewer sections, so the need might not be as acute but certainly remains so that there is appropriate faculty governance for curricula. My example is just that, and I defer to the faculty to define what works best, since I'm sure they have other accreditation experiences that could benefit the overall discussion and definition of process.
