US TAX FILING DEADLINE DELAYED

Both Federal and State of Georgia tax filing deadlines are delayed until July 15, 2020. Form 8843 is still required for any non-US citizen in the US in 2019, regardless of income or income tax. F1 EMPLOYMENT AUTHORIZATION FOR ECONOMIC HARDSHIP

If you are in the US and feel you need work authorization off campus, you may apply for work authorization based on "Severe Economic Hardship". First, review the information on our website, then contact ISAP first.

SHELTER IN PLACE IN GEORGIA

Georgia Gov. Kemp ordered "shelter in place" for all residents in the state of Georgia, effective Friday, April 3rd.

- 1. Shelter In Place: Stay where you are 24/7. Avoid leaving home, except for essential items (groceries, medicine, medical)
- 2. *Quarantine:* Possibly contagious. Remain in a private, closed space away from others for a limited time due to *possible* exposure to an illness. Quarantines are temporary.
- 3. *Isolation:* Sick and very contagious. The sick person must be medically sealed away from others for treatment and observation. Duration varies and depends on recovery.
- 4. *PPE*: Personal Protective Equipment (masks, gloves, screens, medical gowns, etc...) used to treat individuals in isolation, clinics, hospitals or other health care settings.
- 5. Social Distancing: Keep at least 6 ft. between you and the next person at all times.
- 6. *Personal Health Best Practices:* Wash hands with soap and water for 20 seconds. Don't touch your eyes, nose, or mouth. Cover your mouth if you cough.
