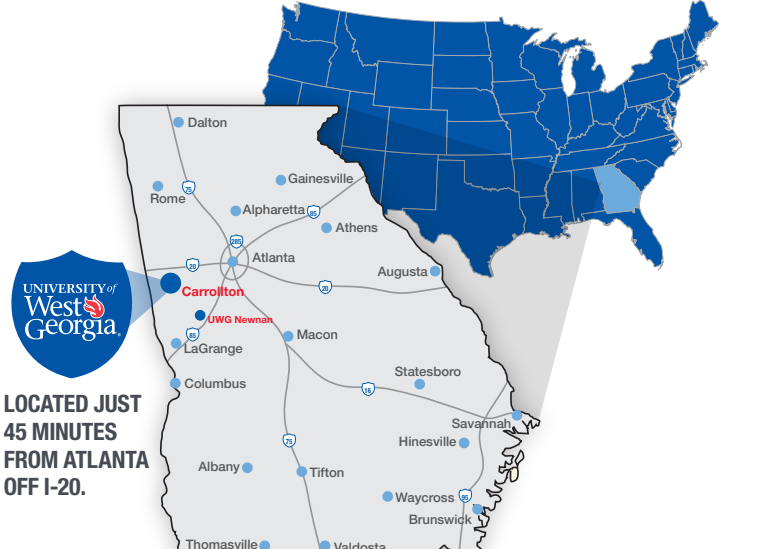

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

UNDERGRADUATE PROGRAMS

Students with less than 30 university-level credits will complete a new student application. Students with 30+ credits will complete a “transfer student” application.

Secondary School (High School) Transcripts: Students must provide an official copy of their secondary school transcripts to the International office. Physical copies by post, or electronic copies by email are acceptable. The University reserves the right to request a foreign credential evaluation in certain situations, or for any post-secondary coursework.

Standardized Exam Scores: RSAT or ACT are required*. Minimum Required Scores: RSAT EBRW - 480, RSAT Math: 450; ACT English: 17, ACT Math: 17*

English Proficiency Exam*: If English is not an official language of your home country, you must sit for a English Proficiency exam. The university prefers the IELTS or TOEFL exams, but other test versions can be accepted. Minimum required scores are: IELTS, 6.0 minimum overall or TOEFL iBT, 69.

Transfer Applicants: If you already have more than 30 university credit hours, you do not need to submit high school transcripts or SAT/ACT scores. However, transcripts of all university level credits without American accreditation must be evaluated by an accredited foreign credential evaluation service. The evaluation must include: a course-by-course evaluation, a GPA calculation, and a certified English translation if the original transcript is not in English. The evaluation may be provided by a member of either NACES.org or AICE-EVAL.org.

GRADUATE PROGRAMS

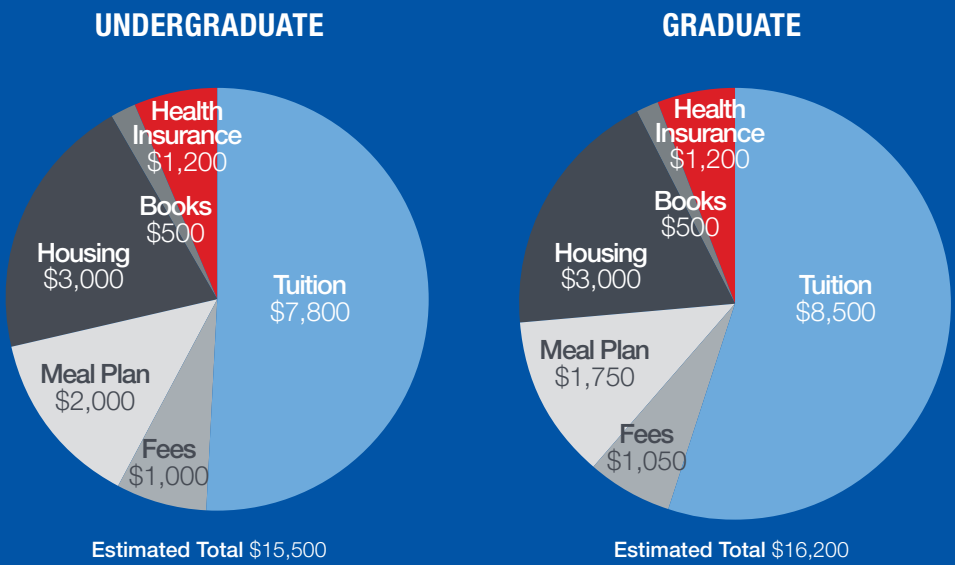
Each graduate degree has unique, program-specific admission requirements. Please see: westga.edu/gradstudies/ In addition, all international applicants must satisfy the requirements below:

Undergraduate Transcripts: University coursework transcripts must receive a foreign credential evaluation in English if the university does not hold American accreditation. Evaluation must include a course-by-course evaluation with a GPA conversion, and be conducted by an organization listed with one of the following organizations: NACES.org or AICE-EVAL.org.

English Proficiency Exam*: If English is not an official language of your home country, you must sit for a English Proficiency exam. The university prefers the IELTS or TOEFL exams, but other test versions can be accepted. Minimum required scores are: IELTS, 6.0 minimum overall or TOEFL iBT, 69. For MBA or MPAcc applications, the minimum scores are IELTS 6.5 or TOEFL iBT 79.

TUITION WAIVERS (SCHOLARSHIPS)

Attracting well-qualified international students is a top priority and part of our mission. Application for a tuition waiver is made after admission to UWG. Our office also assists
