A vaccine non-responder is someone who does not build up an adequate immune response after receiving two rounds of the three dose Hepatitis B vaccination series. Approximately 5 to 15% of people who receive the vaccine are considered non-responders. This is especially important for healthcare workers who may be at increased risk of exposure to Hepatitis B.

Documentation of two completed Hepatitis B vaccination series and two follow-up negative Hepatitis B Antibody titers are required to declare non-responder status. Once declared as a non-responder, this individual will not be required to receive any more Hepatitis B vaccinations or titers.
