□ **Permission to Teach:** *Does not* constitute Graduate Faculty Appointment. Request submitted annually and/or prior to the semester in which the faculty member will teach.

<u>Requisites</u>: Non-tenure track full-time faculty (ranked, lecturer, senior lecturer), part-time faculty, and adjunct faculty. In lieu of terminal degree, the candidate must demonstrate 1) exceptional scholarly activity or professional experience, 2) experience teaching graduate level classes, <u>or</u> 3) evidence of a high potential for effective teaching at the graduate level. <u>Required Materials</u>: Current, up-to-date curriculum vitae; Justification statement addressing 1) Department/program need, 2) Special expertise that the faculty member brings to the graduate program, 3) Qualifications that contribute to the work and progress of graduate students, <u>and</u> 4) Expected duties of the candidate.
