Following is my response to the actions of the Faculty Senate as represented in the minutes of the meeting of February 15, 2013, which were approved at the Faculty Senate meeting on March 8, 2013. All program approvals are made contingent upon the department's commitment to staff the changes out of existing internal funds. Note that Section 3.6.2 of the Board of Regents *Policy Manual* states, *inter alia*: "The termination of educational programs, degrees, or majors shall be submitted to the Chancellor for review and recommendation for action by the Board of Regents." So, all program, degree, and major terminations (as well as additions) need to be approved by the Board. Our requests should include the rationale and the plan for addressing the needs of existing students.

Committee Reports:

Undergraduate Programs Committee

A&B) Motions to modify BM with a major in Theory and Composition and add HIST 4010, ANTH 4130, ANTH 4201, and ANTH 4202 were passed.
