Following is my response to the actions of the Faculty Senate as represented in the minutes of the meeting of November 8, 2019, which were approved at the Faculty Senate meeting on December 6, 2019. Note that Section 3.6.2 of the Board of Regents *Policy Manual* states, *inter alia*: "The termination of educational programs, degrees, or majors shall be submitted to the Chancellor for review and recommendation for action by the Board of Regents." So, all program, degree, and major terminations (as well as additions) need to be approved by the Board.
