



How to set up your Android phone to use the UWG wireless network (if you were previously connected)

First, you need to remove the existing profile from your device. To do this, go to Apps → Settings → Wi-Fi → click the ConnectWestSEC profile and select “forget” from the pop up that appears.





This will prompt you to sign in to a network. Select “ConnectWest”. By selecting this pop-up you will be taken to the screen below.





Next, go to Settings → Wi-Fi and connect to the “ConnectWest” network. A popup should take you to <http://webauth.westga.edu>. Select “Student | Faculty | Staff” and then the button appropriate to you.




Click continue on the following page and then click the green “Start >” button at the bottom





Next select “Direct Download” from the drop down menu and then select “Install”.





On the next two screens you will be prompted for a name and password. Use your UWG ID for this. Be careful as if you enter the wrong info here you may have to start over to actually get connected.



Next you will see a confirmation that the profile was installed. Click "Done" in the top right. Now your device is setup and should connect automatically while on campus.
