

**Welcome to my Econ. 2105 (N03): Summer: June 27 - July 23, 2018.**

**Please read this thoroughly and carefully.**

**I repeat: Please read this thoroughly and carefully.**

- I am Professor Dutt, and I will conduct this class.
- It's entirely online, with one face to face (proctored) final exam.
- If you cannot do any of it, do not enroll in my class.
- I am a veteran professor, with 32 years of college / university teaching experience in the USA, and a "straight shooter" as you will see next.
- I am very flexible, and have only 3 requirements from you.
- **Take 3 exams. That is it.**
- The entire course outline and topics are spelt out.
- I expect you to read the chapter topics, and do the practice quizzes, on your own.
- The quizzes will be open the whole session and will not be graded.
- None of my exams. are comprehensive.
- You will take 2 online exams., and one proctored final exam. on the dates and times mentioned below.
- Exam. 1 is July 5<sup>th</sup> 10 am - July 6<sup>th</sup> 10 pm, 2018. It will be open for 36 hours.
- It will be 40 multiple choice questions (MCQ's), worth 1 point each, and a one hour exam.
- Once you start, the exam. will be open for the next 60 minutes. You have to finish it in one session.
- It will be Chapters 1, 2, 3 and 4 only. Be prepared with these 4 chapters.
- Cannot do it?
- Drop my class. There is no other choice.
- Same with Exam. 2.
- Exam. 2 is July 12<sup>th</sup> 10 am - July 13<sup>th</sup> 10 pm, 2018. It will be open for 36 hours.
- It will be 40 multiple choice questions (MCQ's), worth 1 point each, and a one hour exam.
- Once you start, the exam. will be open for the next 60 minutes. You have to finish it in one session.
- It will be Chapters 5, 6, 7, and 8 only.
- **Very Important: Exam. 1 and 2 are online, and open for 36 hours. You can take it from anywhere (hospital, job, out of state, out of country) and have to take it. You miss it, it's a "Zero" grade. No exceptions. Cannot do it, do not take my class. I will never discuss any**

***exception. My rules are etched in stone. Do not send me any email about missing the exams.***

- The final is a two hour (face to face) proctored (by me) exam. on Friday July 20<sup>th</sup> or Monday July 23<sup>rd</sup>, from 10 am - 12 pm in room 1308, Miller Hall, UWG Carrollton campus. For your convenience I am doing a proctored final exam. on two separate days.
- Email me (I need written documentation) on which day you will take your finals.
- ***This is free. There is no paperwork needed to take this exam. Just show up in the exam room on the date and time mentioned above.***
- If you cannot take this, you can take a "virtually proctored" exam. conducted by UWG's ProctorU service. You can take this from Friday July 21st (10 am) through Monday July 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2018 (11.30 am). Timing will be decided by UWG's ProctorU service and you. You need to fill out forms for this.
- ***I have already done my part of the paperwork, you will do yours. Do the paperwork / fill out the form early.***
- My final exam. is password protected, and only UWG's ProctorU service can open it for you, when you start taking the final. You will pay the fee.
- Let me know within first week of class, by the 5th of July, 2018 by email (I want written documentation) if you will take a UWG proctored online exam.
- The final exam. will have 80 MCQ's, from Chapters 9,11,12,13 and 14.
- ***There are no essay exams, no projects, no case studies, nothing.***
- You will be graded out of a total of 160 points (40+40+80).
- Grading scale is given below.
- I will keep time aside (they are my office hours), where I will have the email open and live.
- The days and times are:
  - July 2nd - 6th: 8-9 pm every day.
  - July 9th - 13th: 8-9 pm every day.
  - July 16th - 20th: 8-9 pm every day.
- Other than that you can email me anytime (absolutely anytime) and I will try to answer you ASAP.
- There are no grades attached to anything, except the 3 exams.
- The chapters and the topics (to read) is under "Entire course outline."
- To additionally help you out, I have mentioned the chapters and the topics of the Quizzes and the final.
- The MCQ's will be from those topics.

- Study them well.
- I will not quiz/ test you on anything else.
