CONCERT REPORTS:

Attend two concerts hosted by the UWG Music Department and write a report about your observations of each concert. Further details regarding the concert reports can be found in Connect assignments list. You may submit your report online via Connect or hardcopy to the music office in the Humanities building.

- Note: Your concert report must discuss a complete live performance hosted by the UWG Department of Music and include a concert program & ticket with your name legibly indicated on each or you will not receive full credit.
