Course Description

The University of West Georgia Marching Band “The Sound That Lights the South” is open to all interested brass, woodwind, percussion, and auxiliary students. The study and performance of musical and visual programs for marching band includes the presentation of field show and standstill performances for all home football games, select away games, exhibitions, and special on-campus events. Permission of the Director may be required.

Required Materials

Members of the ensemble are responsible for having their respective music, drill, coordinates, instrument, pencil, proper attire and materials appropriate to the physical nature of the course, and any other necessary materials at each rehearsal and performance. Any borrowed materials must be returned at the conclusion of the performance season. The loss or damage of any university property will result in a fine to cover the repair and/or replacement of said item(s). For details concerning rehearsal/performance attire, music rehearsal, marching rehearsal, and game day procedures, please refer to the protocol sheets that were disseminated during camp.

Course Objectives

Members of the UWG Marching Band will:

1. be expected to perform music from a wide variety of styles and genres at a high level of musical attainment.
2. demonstrate highly proficient technical skills in both musical and visual aspects of the activity.
3. demonstrate a mature command of sight-reading and memorization skills.
4. contribute to the betterment of university athletics by acting as the spirit and pageantry of the university.
5. carry the name of UWG with them wherever they perform and act as ambassadors of the band program and the university in all ways.
6. Music majors enrolled in 4720 are expected to mentor 2720 level band members and to provide a positive example at all times, including preparation, rehearsal, and performance.

Attendance/Grading Policy

Attendance at all rehearsals and performances of the marching band is mandatory. Of course, I understand that emergencies do occur. To that end, each member will be allowed ONE (1) excused absence for the semester. Any subsequent absences will result in the lowering of the student’s final grade by a letter. If missing a rehearsal becomes unavoidable, you are responsible for contacting the Band Director in advance of said rehearsal (via email). Your one absence may NOT be used to miss a performance. Being counted late to FIVE (5) rehearsals or performance call-times will result in one (1) absence. Performances may be missed (with the permission of the Director) for the following two reasons ONLY: 1. A professional gig. 2. An important family event. If permission is granted by the Director, you must provide a substitute for your position and they must attend all of the week’s rehearsals preceding the performance you will miss. Any missed performances for reasons other than those listed above or in which the services of a substitute are not secured will result in a failing grade in the course for the semester. Students are expected to be professional and punctual to all rehearsals and performances. Any class conflicts that could affect punctuality should be made known to the Drum Major and cleared by the Band Director. *Continued tardiness/absences, chronic unpreparedness, and/or general attitude or behavioral issues may affect the student’s enrollment in other UWG band ensembles and future enrollment in the marching band.*

Friday Rehearsals

Friday rehearsals (5:30-7:30PM) will typically occur only on weeks where there is a game or exhibition that weekend. Those dates are: 8/24, 8/31, 9/7, 9/21, 9/28, 10/12, and 11/2. Friday rehearsals will be held at the Marching Band field (field 3, behind the SRC).

Gameday Rehearsals/Away Trips

Home game rehearsals begin 4 hours prior to kickoff (typically 10AM). Students park in Lot H (Band/Cheerleader parking) and walk to the practice field behind the Athletic Operations Building. Schedules for bus trips to away football games and marching exhibitions will be published at least one week prior to the event.

Communication Methods

All members are required to check their my.westga.edu email accounts on a daily basis for announcements concerning the marching band and are responsible for any/all material contained in said emails. Information concerning the marching band can also be found via the band's website (westga.edu/music/uwgbands), the band's twitter account (@WestGeorgiaBand), and the band's Facebook group (University of West Georgia Bands). Any last minute alterations to the performance or rehearsal schedule of the marching band will be disseminated via these mediums. All communication with the Band Director should be done via official UWG email accounts.
