INSTRUCTOR:

THEA 1100- Theatre Appreciation- University of West Georgia (Fall 2017) This course is an introduction to the principles of the art of live theatre. Students explore the creative process through script analysis, examining current and past theatrical trends, critical thinking and analysis of a theatrical performance, and a collaborative project with their peers.

THEA 3291- Voice and Movement II- University of West Georgia (Fall 2017) This course is a continuation and elaboration of concepts taught in Voice and Movement I. Students will create a working knowledge of IPA and Dialect Acquisition, Heightened Physical Expression, and the possibilities available to them in their vocal and physical artistry.
