Veteran: If you are you a veteran of the U.S. Armed Forces	Provide a copy of your DD214.
Children: If you now have or will you have children who will receive more than half of their support from you between July 1, 2017 and June 30, 2018...	Provide a copy of their birth certificate(s) and complete a household expenses form detailing how you provide financial support.
Dependents: If you have dependents (other than your children or your spouse) who live with you and who will receive more than half of their support from you between July 1, 2017 and June 30, 2018...	Provide documentation of their dependency and complete a household expenses form detailing how you provide support.
Foster care or Ward of the court: At any time, since you turned 13, if your parents were deceased, you were in foster care or you were a ward of the court...	Please provide court documentation.
Emancipated Minor: As determined by a court in your state of legal residence, if you were an emancipated minor...	Provide court documentation.
Legal Guardianship: As determined by a court in your state of legal residence, if you are or were in a permanent legal guardianship...	Provide court documentation.
Unaccompanied Youth who was homeless or at risk of being homeless: At any time on or after July 1, 2016, if you were determined to be an unaccompanied youth who was <i>homeless</i> or were self-supporting <i>and at risk of being homeless</i> , as determined by (a) your high school or district homeless liaison, (b) the director of an emergency shelter or transitional housing program funded by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development, or (c) the director of a runaway or homeless youth basic center or transitional living program	If you meet any one of these stipulations pertaining to an Unaccompanied Youth who was Homeless, please provide documentation from the appropriate person or agency to verify your living status.
