## Spring 2011 Senior Exit Surveys

Forty-Eight graduating seniors responded to our Spring 2011 Senior Exit Survey. Some of the highlights of this survey are as follows:

- 73% reported that they were “Very Satisfied” with their decision to earn a B.B.A. in our department. Another 25% noted that they were “Satisfied” with this decision.
- 71% reported that it was “Very Likely” that they would recommend our program to a friend. The other 29% noted that it was “Likely” that they would recommend our program.
- 31% reported that faculty were “Frequently” available outside of class. The other 69% reported that faculty were “Regularly” available.
- 25 students reported that they planned to work in a company not owned by their family. Six others noted that they planned to work on their MBA and two reported that they planned to work on a graduate degree in law.
- Three students reported they had already accepted a job offer.

As with previous semesters, the surveys remain excellent in our department. Ninety-Eight percent of our graduating seniors reported that the quality of instruction in our department was “Good” or “Excellent.”

One student noted, “I would just like to say that the entire Management Department faculty has always been helpful and willing to give assistance to students. I appreciate my experience at UWG and I value the education I received.”

### What can it do for you?

A "Certificate in Human Resource Management" can provide you with a solid foundation in HRM and potentially make you more attractive to employers. Completion of the requirements will be noted on your transcript, and a certificate will be awarded by the Department of Management.

### Who is eligible?

A "Certificate in Human Resource Management" can be completed by either a business or a non-business major.

Business majors are eligible when they have attained "Major Status" within the Richards College of Business.

Non-Business majors are eligible when they have completed 45 hours of classes with at least a 2.0 GPA.

### What is the cost?

There is no cost. In fact, most students can simply use the "select" courses in their major to complete the requirements.

### How do I apply?
